



### **José Remesal Rodríguez**

I was born in Lora del Río (Seville) on the 27th June 1948. I conducted my higher education studies at the Universidad Complutense in Madrid where I graduated first in Philosophy (1973), and subsequently in History (1975). At the same University I also obtained my PhD in Ancient History (1977). In 1979 I took up the position of associate professor of Ancient History at the Universidad Complutense in Madrid and in 1988 I became full professor of Ancient History at the Universidad de Barcelona.

During my pre-doctoral degree I was appointed non-stipendiary fellow of the Casa de Velázquez in Madrid (1972-1975) a research institution under the French Ministry for Higher Education and Research. During this period I participated in the excavations of Baelo Claudia (Cádiz) and published several works on the site, including a monograph (J. REMESAL RODRÍGUEZ, *La necropolis Sureste de Baelo*. Madrid 1979).

In 1975 I studied the Eastern pottery from Tartessos, which publication still remains a reference on the subject (J. REMESAL RODRÍGUEZ, "Cerámica orientalizante andaluza". *Archivo Español de Arqueología* 1975, 3-21). Afterward, I focused my research on the Roman world and in the two years following my doctoral graduation, I obtained two post-doctoral fellowships: the first at the Italian National Research Council (CNR) in Rome (1977-78) and the second with the Alexander von Humboldt foundation in Heidelberg (1979-80). During these years my knowledge of the Roman world was enhanced by extensive travels within all the countries that once formed part of the Roman Empire. Furthermore, visits to Iraq, Saudi Arabia, Armenia, Azerbaijan and Uzbekistan allowed me to gain deep understanding of the classical Greco-Roman world and the Eastern cultures in all their extension and variety. During my tenure as associate professor at the Universidad Complutense in Madrid I organised two international congresses on the Production and Trade of Oil in the Antiquity (1978 and 1982), which set a starting point for the current research. In the same years, together with Prof. J. M<sup>a</sup> Blázquez contributed to the creation of the journal *Gerión*, acting as secretary from 1983 to 1988). This was the one of the first Spanish journals dedicated to Ancient History studies to reach international audience. In September 1988 I joined the Ancient History chair of the Universidad de Barcelona which gave me the opportunity of further developing my research interests on the Roman World and especially on trade. In 1989 I created CEIPAC (Centro para el estudio de la Interdependencia Provincial en la Antigüedad Clásica) a Centre specialized on the study of the relationships between provinces in the Classical World. At the same time I started the archaeological excavations at mount Testaccio (Rome), co-directed with Prof. J. M<sup>a</sup> Blázquez. Mount Testaccio, at the very centre of the modern city of Rome, used to be a large rubbish dump in Antiquity where thousands of ceramic pots, especially amphorae, were discarded. The vast

quantities of amphorae, whose inscriptions like modern labels provide information on the whole trade process, make Testaccio a site of paramount importance for the study of Roman economy. Based on my work at Testaccio, I created a database about amphorae epigraphy, available online on the website <http://ceipac.ub.edu>, which was included by the UNESCO in the Millenium Programme (Guide to Cultural Resources on the Web of the World Culture Report 2000) as an outstanding reference. Our online database counts more than 34,000 entries and our articles are consulted more than 4,000 times per month (for detailed statistics see: <http://ceipac.ub.edu/awstats/awstats.pl?config=ceipac>) showing the importance of our work for the academic community worldwide. In addition to our work in Rome, I lead projects centered on amphorae study at Colonia Ulpia Traiana (Xanten, Germany), at Brigantium (Bregenz, Austria), in Tunisia (collaborating with the Université de Sousse) and at Leptis Magna (Libya, collaborating with the Università di Roma Tre, Italy).

In 1993 I created a series of monographs called INSTRUMENTA, published by the Royal Academy of History in Madrid and dedicated to the study of social and economic history in the Classic World. The initial objectives aimed at disseminating internationally our work on amphorae epigraphy, at being economically self-sufficient and at eventually generating profits in order to help members of the research group. We have so far published 39 volumes and met all the original aims we set for ourselves.

In the last years I have obtained several competitive research projects funded by the Spanish Ministry of Research and Science (Ministerio de Investigación y Ciencia) to study the production of Hispanic food and to continue with excavations at Mount Testaccio: (PB96-0218; APC1999-0034; BHA2000-0731; APC1999-0033;
